## INTRODUCTION

Bhutan is located in the eastern Himalayas with Nepal, Sikkim, and Arunachal Pradesh with most diverse biodiversity in the region. The landscape falls in the transition zone between Indo-Malayan and Indo-Chinese biogeographic region. JWS was notified in 1993 and from 1<sup>st</sup> May 2017 it got separated from Samdrupjongkhar Forest Division, which is one of the recent sanctuaries that came into management in Bhutan. It has an area of 334.73sq.km and represents the south-eastern part of the country's ecosystem. It lies between 26° 48'N and 26°60'N, 091° 42'E and 092° 08'E; where altitude ranges from 200masl to 4380masl. It consists of all the forest types present in the country from Sub-tropical Forest till Alpine meadows with grasslands along the southern fringes.

Butterflies, estimated around 18,000 species to there in the world and 1318 species in Indian sub continent, 450 species in Pakistan, 245 in Sri Lanka 640 in Nepal and very few is known from Bhutan (Smetacek, 2017). 800 species of Butterflies are estimated to be occurred in the country (Wangdi & Sherub, 2012). In Bhutan butterflies are found from subtropical foothills to high snow capped mountains in the north. Few diversity studies on butterflies are carried out in the country however in JWS there is no single study carried out on butterfly fauna.

“A POCKET GUIDE TO Butterflies of Jomotsangkha Wildlife Sanctuary” is first of its kind with 160 species covering seven families of butterflies. It can be used as a guide to identify and know the diversity of butterfly species.

## METHODOLOGY

To accomplish the present pocket guide; photographs were contributed by all the staffs under our office during field works from riverbeds, stream ways, roads, trails, agriculture fields, settlements, lakes and forest in JWS. Forest type of the study area includes sup tropical grasslands, subtropical forest, warm broadleaved forest, cool broadleaved forest and few photographs were collected from temperate forest too.

Photographs of butterflies were taken from August 2017 to May 2018. Butterflies were observed during day times 08:00 am to 04:00 pm. An opportunistic survey was carried out whenever we were in the field works. Simple nets were used capture some species and Canon Mark II, Nikon D900, Nikon P900 and Samsung Androids mobiles where used to capture photographs. Butterflies were identified using “A Naturalist’s Guide to the BUTTERFLIES OF INDIA, Pakistan, Nepal, Bhutan, Bangladesh and Sri Lhanka (2017) by Peter Smetacet, Butterflies of Bhutan A Field Guide by UWICE, Field Guide for SWALLOWTAILS of Bhutan (2012) by UWICE, BUTTERFLIES OF BHUTAN mountain, hills and valleys between 800 and 3000m (2007) by Piet van der Poel and Tashi Wangchuk, “Field Guide to Hesperiidae (Skippers) of Bhutan (2014) by UWICE and few species were referred to experts within and outside Bhutan.
