Zhemgang Forest Division, with 94.17% of the land under forest cover, has vibrant flora and fauna. The division has a good number of species of conservation importance, including avian species like the White-bellied Heron, Rufous-necked Hornbill, Great Hornbill, Beautiful Nuthatch, Ward's Trogon. The division also has the highest density of 3 tigers/100 sqkm.

Birds are specular and beautiful creatures. Birds play an essential role in nature by helping with pollination, controlling pest populations, seed dispersal, and adding aesthetic values. They are also depicted in many histories and cultures around the world. Bhutan currently has 761 species of birds recorded and identified. The pictorial field guides on flora and fauna play a significant role in documenting the country's rich biodiversity and guide enthusiasts in identification.

## BACKGROUND

Zhemgang Forest Division is located in the south-central part of the Kingdom, situated between 26°49'37.97" - 27°38'11.92" N and 90°15'52.89" - 91°11'4.92" E. The divisional jurisdiction covers seven gewogs under Zhemgang Dzongkhag and a small portion of Langthel gewog under Trongsa Dzongkhag, encompassing a total geographical area of 1518.42 km<sup>2</sup>. Zhemgang Forest Division shares boundaries with Bumthang Forest Division, Phrumsengla National Park, Mongar Forest Division, Jigme Singye Wangchuk National Park, Royal Manas National Park, and Pema Gatshel Forest Division.

The elevation ranges from 95m to 4570m above sea level and has forest types from tropical broadleaved to alpine scrubs. The significant elevation range variation and habitat types make Zhemgang a rich biodiversity hub.

Zhemgang Forest Division has recorded 328 species of birds so far, purely based on an opportunistic approach. It accounts for 43% of bird species recorded in Bhutan. However, the area is expected to harbor more than 500 bird species. There are also many significant conservation bird species in the area.

This book contains an illustration of 298 bird species only. The management earnestly hopes that this pictorial book will benefit individuals interested in the avian diversity of Zhemgang.

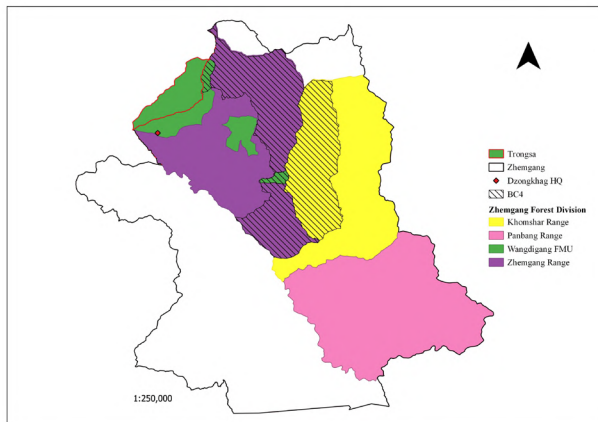


Figure 1: Administrative boundary of Zhemgang Forest Division
