

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Terms and Conditions

1. The interested individual/parties must have valid logging licenses that are registered with the range office and must produce a WBI Registration Certificate along with their logging licenses during the time of registration
2. Interested bidders must inspect and verify forest produce at the site mentioned above in consultation with the range office during office hours before the auction date
3. All potential bidders must fill up the registration form or register before 10.00AM on the day of the auction
4. A registration fee of Nu.300/-(Non-Refundable)with an earnest money deposit(EMD)of Nu.5000/-shall be deposited in Cash Warrant or Demand Draft no later than 10.00 AM on the auction day.
5. The EMD shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidder. However,the EMD of the successful bidder shall be retained until the entire bid value is deposited.
6. The successful bidder shall deposit 50% of the bid value on the auction day and the remaining 50% before the issuance of the clearance by the concerned range office.
7. In the event of a non-deposit of bid value on the auction day the site will be allotted to the next highest bidder.
