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Terms and Conditions

1. The interested individuals/parties must have valid logging licenses that are registered with the range office and must produce a WBI Registration Certificate along with their logging licenses during the time of registration;
2. Interested bidders must inspect and verify forest produce at the site mentioned above in consultation with the range office during office hours before the auction date;
3. All potential bidders must fill-up the registration form or register before 10:00AM on the date of the auction;
4. A registration fee of Nu.300 (Non-refundable) with an earnest money deposit (EMD) of Nu.5000/- shall be deposited in Cash Warrant or demand draft no later than 10:00Am on the day of the auction;
5. The EMD shall be refunded to the unsuccessful bidders. However, the EMD of the successful bidder shall be retained until the entire bid value is deposited;
6. The successful bidder shall deposit 50% of the bid value on the auction day and the remaining 50% before the issuance of the clearance by the concerned range office;
7. In the event of a non-deposit of bid value on the auction day, the site will be allotted to the next highest bidder.
