**OPEN AUCTION**


Divisional Forest Office, Paro is pleased to inform the general public that an open auction of 78.81 CFT of seized Walnut Timber will be conducted on Friday, 29<sup>th</sup> May, 2026, at the Meeting Hall, Divisional Forest Office, Paro Town, starting at 11:00 AM sharp on an "As is Where is basis".

For this, all the interested and eligible individuals or parties are cordially invited to participate in the auction. Prior to the auction, interested bidders who wish to inspect the timber may do so at the Divisional Forest Office during office hours.

**Terms and Conditions**

1. All Bhutanese individual with 18 years and above can participate, interested individuals are required to produce valid CID for verification on the day of auction.
2. Interested individuals must complete registration before 11:00 AM on the day of auction.
3. A registration fee of Nu. 500 (Non-Refundable) with earnest money of Nu. 5000 shall be deposited in the form of cash not later than 10:00 AM on the auction day.
4. Earnest money of the unsuccessful bidder shall be refunded.
5. The highest bidder whose bids are accepted shall have to deposit a spot payment of 50% (in cash) at the hammer price and balance 50% within 10 days from the day of auction.
6. All applicable fees and charges payable to the relevant agency or authority shall be borne by the successful bidder.
7. Failure to deposit 50% sale value as provided in clause 5 shall render the sale invalid, confiscate the earnest money (Nu. 5000) and the purchaser shall be debarred from further participation in the auction.
8. The purchaser shall not be entitled to possession of the timber until the total payment of the bid value. In the event the purchaser fails to make full payment within 10 days. EMD and 50% of the payment as specified in clause 5 shall be forfeited and the lot be resold at the discretion of the committee.
9. The Bidder shall be deemed to have physically inspected the timber to their full satisfaction before bidding.
